### What is the SCA Program?

The **System Coordinated Access (SCA) Program** supports the development and adoption of coordinated access and electronic referral (eReferral) in Ontario.

Working closely with system and community partners, the SCA Program is developing an integrated end-to-end electronic referral strategy focused on connecting providers to available specialists and programs while improving communication between providers and patients.

The SCA Program is funded to support the implementation of the Ocean eReferral Network which is intended to simplify the referral process by allowing primary care providers and their staff to search, find and send referrals electronically.

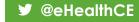
### Strong Support for the Program
